

COWS 2024 Rally Schedule Grafton, WI

Friday, May 17

- Noon 8:00 PM Rally registration in the lobby of Hampton Inn and Suites, 1385 Gateway Drive, Grafton. Bike storage available in the Paramount Conference Room.
- Ice Cream Route 14.3 miles; Ride from the hotel to *Hefner's Frozen Custard and Jumbo Burgers* in Cedarburg. Enjoy the flavor of the day, shakes or burgers at this second-generation local favorite. Indoor and outdoor seating available. Along the way you will pass Cedar Creek, Lime Kiln Park and Cedar Creek Park. Restrooms available in both parks.
- Dinner on your own Walk over to *Water Street Brewery* next door to the hotel or *Juice's Ghost Town* (steak and seafood) across HWY 60. Drive to one of Grafton's other eateries:
 - Milwaukee Ale House Brewpub offering tavern fare, including Friday fish fry, and house ale on 2 floors & promenade decks overlooking the Milwaukee River
 - The Stillery Full menu including Friday fish fry, specialty cocktails including Old Fashioneds, and beer choices, outdoor seating
 - Martini Pete's No food (bring your own or delivery), innovative craft cocktails with fresh ingredients and house infused liquors
